






Be it known that I, THOMAS E. MURRAY, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, county of New York, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Electric-Fuse Cases, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
